



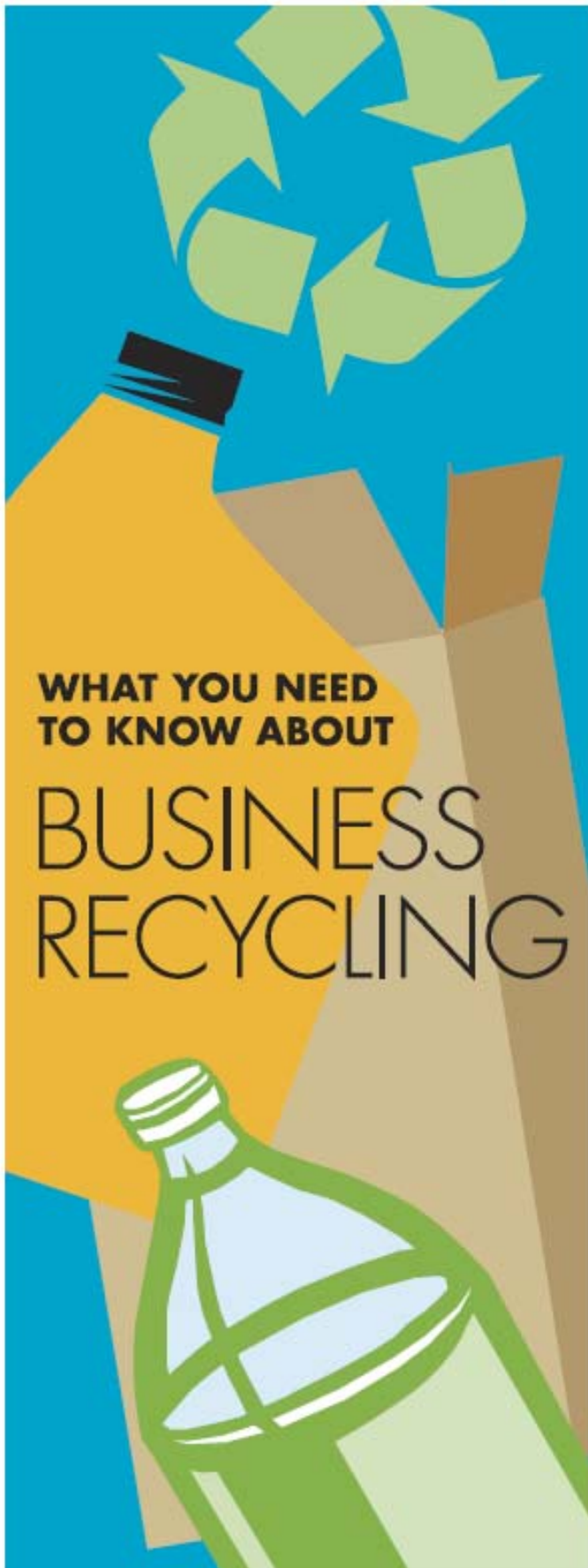
Why recycle?

- State law (AB 341) now requires all businesses that generate four or more cubic yards of waste weekly to recycle. Multi-family properties with five or more units must also recycle.
- Recycling helps conserve resources and extends the life of California's landfills. It also helps create a healthy environment for our community and future generations.

How to get started

It's easy to recycle at your business.

- Make sure your business has arranged for recycling services. Contact CalMet Services at 562-259-1239 for more information and to request recycling service. CalMet provides recycling services FREE of charge to commercial customers within Lomita.
- Use the list provided below to help employees learn what items can be recycled.
- Separate recyclable items from trash inside your business
- Place your recyclable items in external recycling containers for collection.



What items are recyclable?

Aluminum cans and foil
Bottle caps
Magazines and brochures
Newspapers
Wrapping paper
Phonebooks
Cardboard
Cereal boxes absent the inner lining
Egg cartons (Cardboard only)
Juice and milk cartons
Tin cans
Unsoiled foam cups/plates
Glass bottles and jars
Junk mail
Metal Coat Hangers
Plastics
